### Award

A\$750 for best paper from a woman in solar energy research  
A\$250 for best poster from a woman in solar energy research (with paper)  
ASC/ESC Membership for each winner(for 1 year)<sup>1</sup>  
Mentoring if requested

### To be eligible for the award the female applicant must be:

A full-time Honours, Masters or PhD-student at the time of submission of the paper to the APSRC Annual Conference; and  
First author of the submitted paper. The student must have made a significant contribution to the paper.

### Evaluation criteria

There is a prize for the best paper (selected for oral presentation) and for the best poster (with paper).

Evaluation criteria include:

- Scientific quality
- Originality
- Clarity
- Potential impact
- Writing style (best paper)

The decision of the award committee is final.
