International Technology Collaboration Programs under the auspices of the International Energy Agency.

PV Power Systems

- Focusses on the role of photovoltaic solar energy as a cornerstone in the transition to sustainable energy systems

Solar Heating and Cooling

- Focusses on using solar to supply heating, cooling and lighting for buildings and industry.

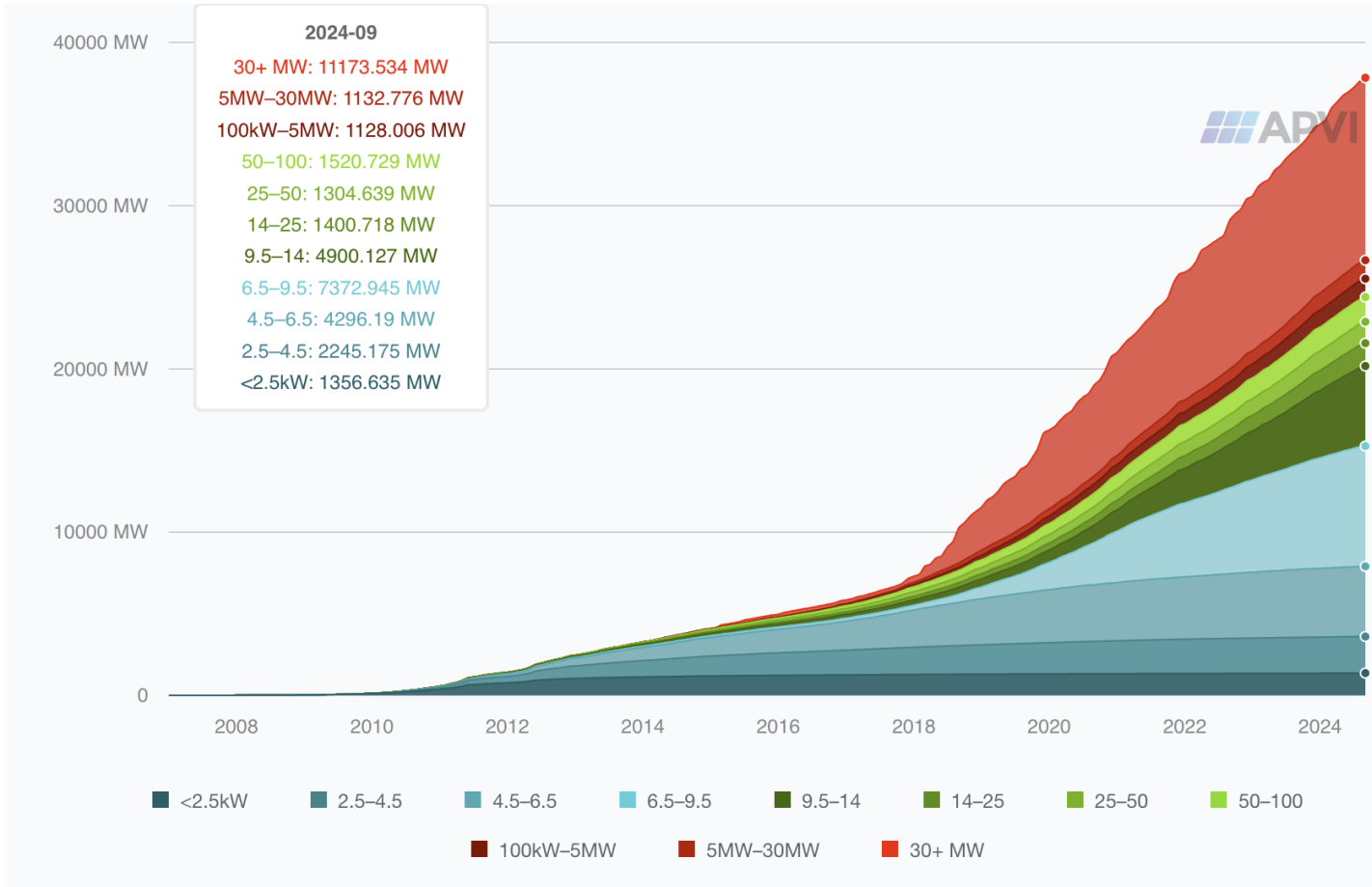

Seed funding from NSW Decarb hub
- ❖ Personalised user electrification roadmap (Electrification 2):
cost benefit analysis for electric appliances
- ❖ Exploring funding opportunities



SOLAR MAPS



- ❖ 37.8GW rooftop PV
- ❖ 19.8GW residential
- ❖ 40% household penetration (revised methodology >15kW)
 - ❖ Likely overestimate (due to replacement systems)
 - ❖ Talking to ARENA / CER to access replacement data

Rebecca Yang is leading a new membership drive to enhance collaboration between solar researchers and industry.

Targeted industries are:

- Dual-use PV (AgriPV, BIPV, floating PV and more)
- PV–thermal cogeneration
- Smart controllers that optimise PV supply and thermal loads
- Next-gen materials for flexible, semi-transparent and high-efficiency PV
- Community energy transition solutions (VPP, demand flexibility)
- Reuse of recycled PV materials
- Digital and automated technologies for PV installation and monitoring
